WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Five Hundred -----

DOLLARS (\$ 500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the east side, of State Highway No. 14 near Washington Baptist Church, about four miles nor thward from the City of Greer, containing three acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING on a nail and stopper in the northern edge of the surfacing of the said highway No. 14, joint corner of the parsonage lot, and runs thence with the parsonage lot line, N. 45-30 E. 132 feet to an iron pin on the original line of Tessie Tapp and the line of Mrs. Bright; thence with the line, S. 75-35 E. 586 feet to an iron pin on the said line, new corner; thence S. 61-00 W. 528 feet to a point in the said highway No. 14; stake or iron pin at 476.5 feet on the northern bank of road; thence with the said road, N. 32-20 W. 368 feet to the beginning corner.
