NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and furthersums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his accont by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Austin Township, North of the Town of Simpsonville, known as Lot No. 32 on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book BB at page 51, and described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin on Pine Lane at corner of lot No. 31, and running thence along said lot South 45-30 East 131.6 feet to a point in center of branch, iron pin back on line 15 feet, thence with said branch as the line, by a traverse line South 27-24 West 147.7 feet to an iron pin, said pin being 20 feet from line in center of branch, thence North 85-40 West 124.4 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 33, thence along line of Lot No. 33, North 10 East 190 feet to an iron pin on Pine Lane, thence North 67-29 East 70.8 feet to the beginning corner.
