"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

In Grove Township, on the Northwestern side of U. S. Highway No. 29, near Grove Station, being Lots Nos. 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 and the lot designated "C.C. Vest and Lula Jane Vest", on Plat of Grove Station Heights made by Piedmont Engineering Service May 18, 1948, and described as follows:
