

EXEMMENTAL ACTION pin in center Robert Chandler Road County Road; thence North 3-30 East 156 feet to iron pin; thence N. 19-45 E. 582 feet to Grove Creek; thence S. 17-30 E. 277 feet to iron pin; thence S. 5-30 E. 242 feet to iron pin center of road thence S. 57-05 W. 365 feet to iron pin beginning corner.
