Smith Batson, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Flora B. Styles, her heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the west side of U. S. Highway 25, near the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINATING at an iron pin on the west side of U. S. Highway No. 25, at the southern corner of Lot No. 23, and running thence with the right-of-way of Highway No. 25, S. 4-09 E., 133.1 feet to the north side of Ellendale Avenue; thence with the north side of Ellendale Avenue, S. 32-21 W., 66.7 feet to the center of line of Old Paris Mountain Road; thence with the center of Old Paris Mountain Road, N. 3-50 E., 138.6 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 23; thence with the line of said property, N. 85-51 E., 47.2 feet to the point of beginning, and being identically the same as conveyed to grantor by deed recorded in Deed Book 275 at Page 335.
