Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL THAT CERTAIN piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the Northwestern side of Langley Drive in the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 44 of Langley Heights, property of Jane G. Hammond, according to a plat made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, June 1937, recorded in the R.M.C. Office of Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "N" at page 133 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
