WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, Greenville, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Five Thousand and No/100ths-----
DOLLARS (\$ 5,000.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six------

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiurns, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southwestern side of White Horse Road near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having according to a plat prepared by Jones & Sutherland, Engineers, dated May 12, 1959, entitled "Property of Annie S. Gregory", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book SS at page 124, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of White Horse Road and a 50 foot road (Randolph Road), and running thence with the Southerly side of the said 50 foot road (Randolph Road) S. 72-39 W. 165.6 feet to an iron pin in the line of other property of the mortgagor herein; thence with the line of the said property of the mortgagor herein S. 17-21 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the line of other property of the mortgagor herein N. 72-39 E. 157.6 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of White Horse Road; thence with the Southwestern side of White Horse Road N. 14-19 W. 150.3 feet to the point of beginning.
