"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, lying on the south side of the U.S. Super Highway No. 29 about one mile westward from the City of Greer, being shown as Lots Nos. 49, 50 and the eastern one-half of Lot No. 51 on a plat of property made for the W.E. Dill Estate by S.C. Moon, Surveyor, dated April, 1940, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Said lots in the aggregate front 125 feet on the south side of said highway, and have a combined rear width of 125 feet, and run back from said highway in a southerly direction in parallel lines to a depth of 200 feet, being bounded on the north by said highway, on the east by Lot No. 48 on said plat, on the south by Lots Nos. 81 and 82, and on the west by the remaining one-half of Lot No. 51; reference to said plat and record thereof is expressly made for a more particularl and definite description of said lots.

The above property is a portion of that conveyed to the mortgagor by John T. Hembree and Robert P. Hembree, et al., by deed dated April 13, 1950, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 409, page 473.
