"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs, Township, in the City of Green, on the south side of Westfield Avenue (formerly known as Maud Street), being shown and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of property of Minnie Teccah, prepared by W.A. Christopher, Surveyor, March 14, 1923, having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the south side of Westfield Avenue 75 feet distant from the corner of Westfield Avenue and School Street, and this being the corner of Lot No. 1 on said plat, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 1, S. 13 E. 200 feet to a point in line of Lot No. 5; thence along the line of last mentioned lot, S. 75-15 W. 70 feet to the corner of Lot No. 3; thence along the line of last mentioned lot, N. 13 W. 200 feet to a point in line of Westfield Avenue; thence along the line of Westfield Avenue, N. 75-15 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
