in O'Neal Township, and described as follows:

BEGINNING on a large poplar on the branch and running thence N. 30-00 W. 985 feet to a point in the center of road; thence down the road as the line S. 15-45 W. 135 feet to a bend in said road; thence S. 5-15 W. 400 feet to an iron pin in said road; thence S. 57-35 E. 667 feet to a stake in the branch; thence up the branch 30 feet to a large poplar, the beginning corner and containing 4 acres.
