If the Mortgagors shall fail to pay any premium for any insurance above mentioned or any taxes, assessment, levy or charge, when due, the Insurance Company may, at its option, make such fayments and in such case the amounts so paid shall immediately become debts due to the Insurance Company by the Mortgagors, shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum until paid, and shall be secured by this mortgage to the same support as the note hereinabove described.
