SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 . . . (\$ 7,500.00 ) Dollars (or for future advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

extended, will be due and payable 18 years after date. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as a part of Lot No. 44 and a part of Lot No. 45 on Oakvale Drive according to a survey made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, March 1946, which said parts are to be known as 33-A, and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the front line of Lot No. 44, which said point is 60 feet North of the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 43 and 44 and running thence S. 72-45 E. 263.2 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot No. 44; thence running along rear line of Lots Nos. 44 and 45, N. 3-30 E. 72.1 feet to a point in rear line of Lot No. 45; thence turning and running N. 72-45 W. 259.2 feet to a point in front line of Lot No. 45; thence turning and running along Oakvale Drive, S. 9-45 E. 33 feet to joint front corner of Lots Nos. 45 and 44; thence continuing along Oakvale Drive, S. 18-30 W. 40 feet to the point of beginning; being the same property conveyed to mortgagor corporation by Eloise M. Flanagan by deed dated January 12, 1960 not yet recorded.
