BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Quinlan Drive, at joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15, and runs thence along the line of Lot 14, N. 5-10 W. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 16, N. 70-00 E. 143 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Rio Vista Drive; thence with Rio Vista Drive, S. 21-35 E. 20 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Rio Vista Drive (the chord being S. 7-38 E. 84.9 feet) to an iron pin; thence still with the curve of Rio Vista Drive (the chord being S. 27-36 W. 51.6 feet) to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Quinlan Drive and Rio Vista Drive (the chord being S. 48-30 W. 18.3) to an iron pin on the North side of Quinlan Drive; thence along the curve of Quinlan Drive (the chord heing S. 66-50 W. 57 feet) to an iron pin on Quinlan Drive; thence continuing with Quinlan Drive, S. 84-50 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to me by H.
