MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN.

WHEREAS, Frank Oliver Ferguson

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto W. A. Copeland

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Five thousand and no/100

Dollars (\$ 5,000.00) due and payable at \$96.67 per month each month for five years.

with interest thereon from date of the rate of 6% per centum per annum, to be paid monthly.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does, grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain place, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Glick Springs Township, about two miles South of Glick Springs, on the south side of Brighty Creek Road, containing 6.5 acres, the same according to plat of the property of the grantor and surveyor, John C. Glick, R.R. #1, route #1000, the following description, to-wit:

Real estate consisting of 6.5 acres, lying in Glick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, bounded on the North by the south line of the road leading from Glick Springs to the south line of the property, on the East by the south line of the property, on the West by the north line of the property, and on the South by the north line of the property, containing 6.5 acres, surveyed by John C. Glick, R.R. #1, route #1000, the following description, to-wit:

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way, incident, or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
