NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid that, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has grant-day sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL the certain place, parcel or lof of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, in the St. Mark Church Community, being bounded on the south, west and north by lands of Minnie Hodge and Alliene Hodge Wood, and on the east by lands of C.B. Loftis, formerly the Cannada Land, and being a part of the same lot of land conveyed to Jacob Hodge, Jr. by Jacob Hodge, Sr, by deed Feb. 8th, 1918, recorded in the Office of the M. for Greenville County in Dedd Book 42, at page 319, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

DECIMAING on an iron pin on the C.R. Loftis line at a point N. 24-30 W. 109 feet from the southwastcorner of the original Joseph Hodge, Jr. lot, and runs thence with the C.B.
