12. AND IT IS FURTHER COVENANTED, That the rights and remedies hereunder are cumulative and adoption of any one or more of the said remedies shall not impair the other rights and remedies herein conferred upon the mortgagee, or otherwise given by law, all or any of which remedies may be pursued separately or concurrently.

herein secured or any part of the principal or interest thereof, or any other item secured hereunder, may be renewed from time to time by the mortgagee at his or its option at the request of the then owners of the mortgaged property, or at the request of any party bound thereon, without the consent of or notice to other parties bound thereon and without releasing them from any liability then existing.
