C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Townslip, in the Rocky Greek Church community, being bounded on the northwest by lands of J. J. Busha, on all other sides by lands of B. H. Hudson, and being a part of the name tract of land that was conveyed to B.H. Hudson by deed from W. A.
