NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt; and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County, of Greenville, in Bates Township, situate on the south side of the Old Buncombe Road, leading from Green, S. C., to Hendersonville, N. C., and having, according to a survey made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated August 18, 1945, the following meter and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the center of the Old Buncombe Road, at the joint corners of property now or formerly of Wells Talley, thence with the line of said property, S 26-30 W, 353 feet to an iron pin on the west bank of a gully; thence down said gully as the line, S 24-45 E, 126 feet to a bend; thence S 39-15 E, 255 feet to an iron pin at the foot of a maple tree; thence with a small branch as the line, the following courses and distances: S 18-00 W, 80.5 feet; S 45-20 W, 254 feet to a bend; thence S 82-50 W, 216 feet to a bend; thence S 53-50 W, 195 feet to an iron pin at corner of property now or formerly of E.
