Highway No. 253) and Hilltop Drive, and running thence along the East side of Hilltop Drive, N. 15-07 E. 400 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 64 and 65; thence along the joint line between said lots, S. 69-29 E. 228.4 fect to an iron pin; themce along the rear lines of Lots 64, 63 and 62, S. 40-16 W. 422.9 feet to an iron pin on the north side of the Little Texas Road; thence along the north side of the Little Texas Road, N. 69-51 W. 48.2 feet to the beginning corner.
