KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I the said J. Leon Hix

aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to me the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, in the new city limits of Greer, lying on the north side of Old U. S. Highway N. 29, (now West Poinsett Street), being shown and designated as all of lot No. 39 on plat of property of Planters Savings Bank of Greer, S. C., said plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "U" pages 22 and 23, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINING on an iron pin on the North side of said Poinsett Street, joint corner of lots 38 and 39, and runs thence with the common line of said lots, N. 12-00 E., 175 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of lots 39 and 31, N. 78-00 W., 65 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 39 and 40; thence with the common line of lots 39 and 40, S. 12-00 W., 175 feet to an iron pin on the North side of said Poinsett Street; thence with the north side of said Poinsett Street, S. 78-00E., 65 feet to the beginning corner.

A drive-way extending from said Poinsett Street along the western edge of the above described lot and the eastern edge of Lot No. 40, now owned or formerly owned by D. N. Smith, has been opened to a point in the rear of the dwelling situated on the property herein conveyed. It is understood and agreed that said drive-way shall remain open at all times and may be extended to such depth as necessary for the convenience of the owners of said two lots and improvements now or to be hereafter made on same.

This is the same property conveyed to Kenneth Smith by deed dated January 8, 1952 in deed book 448 page 520, in the Office for the R. M. C. for Greenville County.
