That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN 'ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

N. Willis, Surveyor, October 28, 1948, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at Page 77, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Pinehurst Drive at the front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, of Block C, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 62-23 E. 139.9 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lots; thence S. 25-58 E. 90 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 11, of Block C, at a point half-way between the corners of Lots Nos. 10 and 12, of Block C; thence on a new line through the middle of said Lot No. 11, of Block C, S. 62-23 W. 138.9 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the front line of said lot at a point half-way between the corners of Lots Nos. 10 and 12, of Block C; thence along the northeast side of Pinehurst Drive, N. 26-48 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner.

The northwestern half of Lot No. 11 being the same conveyed to H. H. Hill and Era W. Hill by Julia Dean Whilden by deed dated March 24, 1955, and recorded in the R. M. C. Whilden by deed dated March 26, 4955 and recorded in said R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 521, at Page 330.

The said H. H. Hill conveyed his one-half interest in both pieces of property to Era W. Hill by deed dated September 11, 1956 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 561, at Page 168. The said Era W. Hill conveyed an interest to Mary Alice Cromer by fleed dated August 10, 1959 and recorded in Deed Vol. 635, at Page 298.
