If any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties, that we, the mortgagors, and to hold and enjoy the said premises until default of payment shall be made.

And if at any time any part of said debt or interest thereon, be past due and unpaid we hereby assign the rents and profits of the above described premises to said mortgagee, or its successors likely.
