cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of
Fifty Nine and 07/100, , , , , , (\$ 59.07 ) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal.
