SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain premissory note in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

Four Thousand, Fight Hundred and No/100 - (\$ 4, Dollars for for tuture advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of...

Forty-Eight and 10/100 --each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal. The last payment on said note, if not paid earlier and if not subsequently extended, will be due and payable 12 ----(s

extended, will be due and payable 12 years after date. The note fifther provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor (s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said EIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signifing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit: whereof is hereby acknowledged), hgain, sell and release unto the said following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, on the southeast side of West View Avenue, and being known and designated as Lot No. 14, of Block A, on plat of East Highlands, as made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in April, 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 35 and 36, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of West View Avenue, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, of Block A, said point being 60 feet northeast from the corner of the intersection of West View Avenue and Sunset Drive, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 13, S. 52-50 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of a 5-foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with the edge of said strip, N. 37-00 E. 63.7 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15, of Block A; thence with the line of Lot No. 15, N. 52-43 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on the south east side of West View Avenue; thence with the southeast side of West View Avenue, S. 37-00 W. 64.2 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to Thomas E. Belcher and Edith Mayes Belcher by Roy D. Jones by deed dated March 31, 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 252, at page 196, the said Thomas E. Belcher died testate on the 3rd day of February, 1961, and he willed all of his property to the within mortgagor, Edith Mayes Belcher. The probate of his estate is filed in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenwood County, Greenwood, South Carolina. " 8
