## MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Mary Barnette Hudson, Bruce Forest Hudson, Glen W. Hudson and Raymond E. Hudson (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) CHEETING

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Four Thousand and no/100----

DOLLARS (\$ 4,000.00--- ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six & one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, In School District 10-A, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in Parker Road, corner of the property conveyed this day by me to Alvin Bridwell; thence along the Parker Road, N. 7-15 W. 445.5 feet to an iron pin in said road; thence continuing with the said road, N. 30-22 W. 175.6 feet to an iron pin in said road, corner in Lucile C. Jones line; thence with the line of the Lucile C. Jones land, S. 43-16 W. 545.6 feet to a stone on line of theproperty of the grantor; thence with said line, S. 28-40 E. 265.9 feet to an iron pipe; thence with the line of the said Bridwell lot, N. 84-30 E. 394 feet to the point of Beginning.
