C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to me the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances: BEGINNING on a pin in the community road; running thence N. 1.00 E. 349 ft. to a stake; thence S. 85.00 W. 318 ft. to a stake; thence S. 34.40 E. 134 ft. to a stake; thence S 1.15 W. 233.5 ft. to a pin in the above said road; thence with the said road as the line N. 85.15 E. 240 ft. to the beginning corner, containing two acres. The above described land is joined on the south by Loyd Poole and on the west by C. M. Ponder and on the north and eastby Malcolm A. Mason. The above described land is a portion of the same land conveyed to Malcolm A. Mason by T. M. Crain on the 13th day of March 1948 and is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 3h3, page 91.
This is the same property conveyed to me by deed by Malcolm A. Mason dated Oct. 4th, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 464 page 426. ALSO all that certain piece, parcel or lot of Land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, O'Neal Township, about one mile north from O'Neal, lying on the north side of a community road, being bounded on the north by lands formerly of C. M. Ponder and a branch, on the east by a tract conveyed to James A. Reid, on the south by the said road and lands formerly of Lloyd Poole and on the west by lot of the Benson Kemp and other lands formerly of C. M. Ponder, and being a part of the same tract conveyed to Malcolm A. Mason by deed from T. M. Crain, recorded in the office of the R. M.
