One-half acre was conveyed by said Church to the Jonesville School District # 5A by deed recorded in Deed Book 69, Page 201 and was reconveyed to the Mortgagor as New Pilgrim Baptist Church by deed recorded in Deed Book 521 at Page 118. The Mortgagor became known as New Pilgrim Baptist Church by Resolution of the Church made in the year 1928. Said Resolution and change of name was made to distinguish this Church from the Church located on Woodruff Road. The Woodruff Road location was the prior location of this Church, was abandoned in about the year 1895. Another group reopeded the Church on Woodruff Road and because of the old building became known, and is still known, as Old Pilgrim Baptist Church.
