on the southeastern side of Georgia Road, and being shown as 120 foot lot on plat entitled "Property of Standing Springs Baptist Church" prepared by C. O. Riddle, dated April 27, 1953, plus an additional thirty feet on either side of said lot and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
