NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Lowell H. Tankersley

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, hargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Sitton, his heirs and assigns forever;

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, containing 25 acres, more or less, lying and being near the westerly side of White Horse Road adjoining a portion of the westerly side of the Subdivision known as Parkdale (Plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR, page 55), and being the westerly portion of that part of the M. O. Lathem Estate known as "The Jesse French Place," Plat thereof being recorded in the RMC Office in Plat Book \_\_\_\_\_\_, page \_\_\_\_ and having according to the two plats referred to above, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin marking the northwesterly corner of Lot No. 11 on the plat of Parkdale, above referred to, and running thence according to the plat of the Jesse French Place, referred to above, S 59-30 W 69.2 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S 65-41 W 1,295 feet to a stone; thence turning and running S 9-30 E 831.6 feet to a stone; thence turning and running N 52-00 E 350 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot 16 as shown on the Parkdale plat, which point is 23.6 feet, more or less, N 27-57 W of the joint rear corner of Lots 16 and 17; thence turning and running according to the Parkdale plat with the rear line of Lot No. 16 N 27-57 W 117.4 feet, more or less, to a point on the southwesterly side of an unnamed street; thence continuing on the same course across said unnamed street and along a portion of the rear line of Lot No. 15 of Parkdale N 27-57 W 137.6 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running along the rear line of Lots 15, 14, 13, 12 and 11 of Parkdale N 3-22 W 476.1 feet to the point of beginning.
