"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northern side of Algonquin Trail, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 on Plat of Property of Oeland-Simpson Lumber Company by Webb Surveying and Mapping Company, dated March 14, 1964, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
