Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that lot of land with improvements lying on the eastern side of Jones Avenue in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 15, a three-foot strip of Lot No. 16, and the northern one-half of Lot No. 14 on a Plat of the Property of W.C. McDaniel prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated November 1926 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book H, Page 102, and having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Jones Avenue in the center of Lot No. 14 (said iron pin being located 157.5 feet from the intersection of Jones Avenue with Tindal Avenue) and running thence through Lot No. 14, S. 89-08 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-18 E. 97.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89-08 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on Jones Avenue; thence with the eastern side of Jones Avenue, S. 1-18 W. 97.5 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever.
