MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, George D. Stewart, of Greenville County,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagoe to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeastern side of Landwood Avenue, formerly Fairview Avenue, being known and designated as Lot 21, Block K, as shown on plat of Fair Heights Subdivision by R. E. Dalton, dated October 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 257 and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Landwood Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 20 and 21 and running thence with the joint line of said lot, S. 58-40 E. 136.1 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the rear of Lot s 21 and 4, N. 31-20 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 21 and 22; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 58-40 W. 135.7 feet to an iron pin on Landwood Avenue, joint front corner of said lots; thence with said Avenue, S. 31-47 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint of beginning; being a portion of the same conveyed to the mortgagor by H. B. Riddle by deed dated September 15, 1964 and recorded in Deed Vol. 758 at Page 226."
