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- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgages for such fur ther sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgages, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. - (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions inst the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged

Should any legal preceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mertgage, or should the Me gages become a party of any suit involving this Mortgages or the title to the gremises described herein, or should the debt secured here any part thereof be placed in the hands of any attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred the Mortgages, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgages, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
- (7) That the Mortgager shall held and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mertgage or in the note pred hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgager shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covers of the mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; etherwise to remain in full nants of the mortg
- (8) That the covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, of the parties hereto.
