NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate on the Northeast side of Leone Avenue, being shown and designated as Lot 14 on plat of the property of American Bank and Trust Company prepared by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, September, 1924, and recorded in Plat Book F at page 254 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Leone Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots 13 and 14 and running thence with the line of Lot 13, N. 49-30 E. 175 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 12 and 15; thence with the line of Lot 15, N. 40-30 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 15, 16 and 17; thence with the line of Lot 17, S. 49-30 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Leone Avenue; thence with the line of said Avenue, S. 40-30 E.75 feet to the point of Beginning.

Being the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors by deed of N. S. Wilson recorded in Deed Book 555 at page 136.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
