TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: **CAROLINA RENTALS, INC.**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, Greenville, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **Eight Thousand Five Hundred and No/100ths-----** DOLLARS (\$ **8,500.00**), with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable, **September 1, 1985**

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Catlin Circle near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a portion of Lot No. 13 as shown on a plat of The Glen Farms, prepared by H.S. Brockman, dated August 26, 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book M at page 75, and being known and designated as Lot No. 7 as shown on a plat of Hyde Park, prepared by R.B. Bruce, dated June, 1963, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book YY at page 141, and having according to the last mentioned plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Catlin Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 6 N. 73 E. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 17 of Glenn Farms, S. 17-0 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 S. 73 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Catlin Circle; thence with the Eastern side of Catlin Circle N. 17-0 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of C.E. Robinson, Jr. and John F. Chandler, dated June 3, 1964, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 750 at page 478.
