"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Austin Township, being on the southeastern side of South Carolina Highway 417 and having, according to plat of property of H. S. King, prepared by C. O. Riddle, dated January, 1965, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a nail in the center line of South Carolina Highway 417 and running thence with property now or formerly of Lucy H.
