NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township containing 53.25 acres, more or less, less however 1 acre conveyed by the mortgagor to William P. Lockaby by deed recorded in Deed Book 697 at Page 219. The original 53.25 acre tract being described according to a plat by H. S. Brockman dated December 9, 1949 as follows:

W. Greer, S 23 E, 892 feet to a stone; thence S 69-30 W, 2,023 feet along the line of Harriston property to a stake near a large W. O.; thence N 59-45 W, 600.5 feet to a point in the abandoned Chick Springs Road near Enoree River; thence along said abandoned road N 31 E, 185 feet to an angle; thence N 29-15 E, 396 feet to a bend; thence N 37-30 E 165 feet to a bend; thence N 60-05 E, 189 feet to a point on the bank of a surfaced road; thence N 36-30 W, 195.5 feet to the beginning corner.
