Dollars to me the said mortgagor... in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, about one mile east of Brushy Creek Baptist Church; lying on the north side of the Brushy Creek Road (upper route), being a part of the same land conveyed to Lucile A.Kluge By deed from H. K. Kluge May Lth 1953, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 177 at page 374, and being shown as Lot No. 2 on Plat of Property of Lucile Anne Kluge made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, April 25th 1962, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on a stake in the center of a proposed road at a distance of 210 feet the center of the said Brushy Creek Road and on the line of Moore, and runs thence with the center of the said proposed new road and the Moore line, N. 24-00 W. 100 feet to an iron pin and joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence with the common line of the said two lots, S. 66-00 W. 20 feet to an iron pin, then continueing with the same course for a total distance of 218.6 feet to an iron pin on the Morris Smith Subdivision; thence with the common line of Morris Smith and of Lucile Anne Kluge property, S. 18-45 E. 100.4 feet to an iron pin on the said line and joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence with the common line of Iots Nos. 1 and 2, N. 66-00 E. 228.1 feet to the beginning corner, containing Fifty One One-hundreths of one acres, (0,51) more or less.
