To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Kenneth T. White and Donnie Jean White, of Greenville County

... (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(SI GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Seventeen Thousand and No/100------(\$ 17,1000,00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Caroline County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, being shown on a plat of property of J. I. Spears, dated June 1, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book LL at page 100 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point in the center of said road and running thence N. 86-21 E 28 feet to an iron pin on the east side of said road; thence continuing N. 86-21 E. 208.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of J. R. Moore, S. 6-57 W. 201.7 feet to an iron pin at the corner of property now or formerly of Joel I. Spears; thence with the line of that property, N. 6-00 W. 118.6 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the line of said property now or formerly of Joel I. Spears, S. 84-00 W. 212.8 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Grove Road; thence continuing with the same course, 28.6 feet, to a point in the center line of said road; thence with the center line of said road, N. 24-17 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Joel I. Spears by deed dated August 3, 1965 and redorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 779 at page 323."
