MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot 26 of a subdivision known as Kirkwood Heights as shown on plat thereof prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, October 1954, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at Pages 110 and 111 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern edge of Birchwood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 26 and 27 and running thence along the northern edge of Birchwood Drive, S. 72-04 W. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of Birchwood Drive as it intersects with Edgewood Drive, the chord being N. 62-56 W. 35.3 feet to an iron pin on the eastern edge of Edgewood Drive; thence along the eastern edge of Edgewood Drive, N. 17-56 W. 125 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 42; thence along the line of that lot, N. 72-04 E. 80 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 27 and 26; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 17-56 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Harold J. Herbert by deed dated September 14, 1963 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 729 at Page 596."
