

First Mortgage on Real Estate

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: J. MACK WOODS AND W. R. WOODS,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, located on the northeastern side of Ray Street, shown on a plat of property of J. H. Alexander, prepared by C. O. Riddle, R. L. S., on December 2, 1965, and having according thereto the following courses and distances to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of J. H. Alexander property, on the northeastern side of Ray Street, and running thence $N.\ 29-47$ E. 121.1 feet to an iron pin; thence $N.\ 70-14$ E. 68.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along a new line S. 33-32 E. 110.25 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Eunice F. Faircloth property S. 62-34 W. 135.75 feet to an iron pin; thence along Ray Street $N.\ 66-00$ W. 70 feet to the point of beginning.
