"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Grove Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 and having 1.63 acres, more or less, according to a plat of property of L. W. Young prepared by C. O. Riddle dated April 1955, recorded in Plat Book II, page 119 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
