along the margin of Lake Lanier, a traverse line being N. 74-51 E. 76.5 feet to an old iron pin at the northwest corner of said park area; thence along the line of said park area, S. 20-35 E. 121.7 feet to the beginning corner, together with a perpetual easement of right-of-way on and over that portion of a cement roadway which crosses the 30 foot strip of Lot 329 which is not conveyed herein, this easement to be used in common with other owners of lake property and to inure to the benefit of the grantees herein and their heirs and assigns forever.
