## MORTGAGE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Frank B.-Halter and R. B. Landers

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, having according to survey of Piedmont Engineers, dated January 24, 1966, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of Old Spartanburg Road, at corner of property now or formerly of Thomas Milton Higgins, and running thence with the line of said property N. 1-45 E. 294 feet to a pin; thence N. 87-09 W. 100 feet; N. 2-43 E. 427 feet; N. 32-45 E. 143 feet; S. 33-28 E. 448 feet; S. 23-45 W. 218.2 feet; S. 45-57 E. 111 feet, and S. 33-50 E. 184 feet to the center of Old Spartanburg Road; thence with the center of said Road, as follows: S. 81-00 W. 197.7 feet; thence continuing S. 86-34 W. 153 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by deed recorded in Deed Book 791 at Page 471.
