MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern: WILLIAM H. BOUKNIGHT AND VIRGINIA R. BOUKNIGHT (SAME AS WILLIAM H. BAUKNIGHT AND VIRGINIA R. BAUKNIGHT)

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of Nineteen

Thousand and No/100----- (\$19,000.00-----) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

therein specified in installments of One Hundred Thirty-One and 28/100----- (\$ 131.28-----) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 25-----years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the westerly side of Neely Ferry Road, being shown on plat entitled Property of R. L. and Heyward Thompson, dated 3 April 1957, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "WW", at Page 273, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of Neely Ferry Road, which point is located N. 59-05 E. 31.4 feet from an iron pin on the westerly side of Neely Ferry Road, and running thence along center of said Road S. 19-50 E. 43.4 feet to a point; thence continuing with said Road S. 16-50 E. 231 feet to a point; thence still continuing with said Road S. 25-50 E. 234.5 feet to a point in said Road, which point is located N. 64-14 E. 27.4 feet from an iron pin on the westerly edge of said Road; thence leaving said Road and running S. 64-14 W. 446.8 feet to an iron pin in line of Heyward Thompson; thence with line of Heyward Thompson N. 30-03 W. 358.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 21-25 E. 167.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of R. L. Thompson N. 59-05 E. 392 feet to a point in Neely Ferry Road, the same being the point of BEGINNING.
