To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Robert L. Watkins, Jr. and Tamara A. Watkins, of Greenville County,

....(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgager in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgager to the Mortgager's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 19, Block F, of property known as Chapin Springs Land Company according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, at Page 41, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast corner of the intersection of Rose Avenue and Houston Street, and running thence with the eastern side of Houston Street, N. 2-0 E. 50.1 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lots 19 and 20; and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 88-00 E. 126 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 18; thence along the line of Lot No. 18, S. 2-00 E. 50 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Rose Avenue; thence along the northern side of Rose Avenue, S. 88-00 W. 130 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Arthur W.
