NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate at the South-

eastern corner of the intersection of Covington Road and Queensbuty Road in Paris Mountain Township, being shown and desginated as Lot 133 on a plat of Section 3 of Northwood Hills, recorded in Plat Book YY at page 37 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Covington Road at the joint corner of Lots 133 and 134 and running thence with the line of Lot 134, S. 2-10 E. 184.2 feet to a pin at corner of Lot 131, S. 88-29 W. 102.9 feet to a pin atcorner of Lot 132; thence with the line of Lot 132 N. 68-52 W. 120.6 feet to a pin on Queensbury Road; thence with the Eastern side of Queensbury Road, N. 18-45 E. 133.2 feet to a pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Queensbury Road and Covington Road, the chord of which is N. 54-59 W. 40.5 feet to a pin on Covington Road; thence with the Southern side of Covington Road, S. 88-26 E. 133 feet to the point of beginning.
