MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I. George Parr, Jr., of Greenville County

.. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Fourteen Thousand, Eight Hundred and No/100------(\$ 14,800.00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the Town of Taylors, lying and being on the westerly side of Whitman Drive, being shown as Lot No. 54 on the plat of Heathwood as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book KK at page 35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Whitman Drive at apoint 279 feet South of the southwesterly corner of the intersection of Whitman Drive and East Heathwood Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 54 and 55, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 80-06 W. 210 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 61; thence along the line of Lot No. 61 and Lot No. 63, S. 9-54 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 53 and 54; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 80-06 E. 210 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Whitman Drive; thence along the westerly side of said drive, N. 9-54 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by Leona Grumbles by deed dated June 28, 1967 to be recorded herewith."
