MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Henry A. Seeger and Helen B. Seeger, of Greenville County,

\_\_(hereinafter reterred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Ten Thousand, Three Hundred and No/100-----(\$ 10, 300.00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgage, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgager, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgager to the Mortgager's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgager in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 19 according to plat of Trammell Heights known as Property of R. J. Bowley and reference is made to plat by J. Mac Richardson, L. S., dated August 1953, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at Page 28 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southern corner of the intersection of New Dunham Bridge Road and Foster Drive; thence with the southeastern side of New Dunham Bridge Road, S. 34-19 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of New Dunham Bridge Road at the joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19; thence with the joint line of Lots 18 and 19, S. 55-41 E. 175 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 18 and 19; thence with the joint line of Lots 19 and 20, N. 33-55 E. 102.8 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Foster Drive; thence with the southwestern side of Foster Drive; thence with the southwestern side of Foster Drive, N. 57 W. 175 feet to the intersection of New Dunham Bridge Road and Foster Drive, the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Holland Reeves and Louise M. Reeves by deed of even date to be recorded herewith."
