"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Range View Circle (formerly Dena Drive), containing 2.25 acres, and having, according to plat made by T. T. Dill, April 8, 1964, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Range View Circle, formerly Dena Drive, at corner of property of Harold Morgan, and running thence with Range View Circle, S. 68-47 W. 300 feet to corner of property now or formerly owned by Harold Morgan; thence with line of said property S. 22-18 E. 403 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 37-05 E. 342 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 21-23 W. 224 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is also shown as Lot 7.7, Block 1, Sheet B13.3 on the County Block Book, and is the same property conveyed to the Deacons of Triune Baptist Church by deed recorded in Deed Book 749 at page 466. The name of the Church has been changed since the receipt of said deed to White Horse Heights Baptist Church.
